SUPERFIGHT LAS VEGAS 2026

Want to take a moment to explain the Superfights which will take place on stage during the "Dinner & A Fight" event, which takes place on the last evening of the World Martial Arts event annually in Las Vegas.

A list of the best and most skilled fighters from each school worldwide will be submitted to event director. The Superfights will consist of 5.0 Fighting matches and 5.0 Grappling matches. Must be a black belt in any of our 5.0 programs to be considered. The Superfight contenders will be chosen by each school owner. Schools may submit a maximum of one contender for each category below before registration for the event closes. If we have more than two contenders for a particular division, we will have elimination matches the day before the Dinner & Fight event to arrive at our two contenders.

We will follow the 5.0 fighting and 5.0 grappling rules. As you all know, 5.0 Grappling for everyone has been changed to one 3 minute round, however only in our Superfight event, the 5.0 Fighting will also be a one 3 minute round.

The categories pre-chosen for the 2026 Superfights are listed below. Every year we will choose different categories.

Frequently Asked Questions about the Las Vegas Event

How do I register for the event?

Please register online at https://jskenpo50.smoothcomp.com if you need assistance please contact your studio instructor or administrator. Must register by final deadline of May 31, 2026. The earlier you register, the more you save!

Can I only participate in the tournament or advanced test and not pay for/join the seminars?

No. The entree fee into the event includes the seminars, which is the core of what we do. The seminars are crucial to the learning experience of every martial artist. The tournament however, is optional. There is additional cost for the belt testing.

Do we have to stay at the Rio Hotel & Casino?

Not required, though we highly recommend! We have a block of rooms reserved for the event with discounted room rates and discounted resort fees. If you find cheaper room rates online for the hotel, please always let us know so we can ask the hotel to adjust. Also it is very important that you use our group code, that is how we get our banquet rooms. It is much easier to travel to and from the activities throughout the event if you stay at the Rio.

If my rank and/or weight changes before the event, do I need to update?

ABSOLUTELY! If information is inaccurate, you risk the chance of being disqualified from the competition. For any changes, please login to your SMOOTHCOMP account and make the changes to your registration before the deadline of May 31, 2026.

Can we make changes to competition events (add, remove, swap)?

Yes, before May 31, 2026. You may add through SMOOTHCOMP if you have not registered for any competition events. Otherwise, please email us to remove, swap, or for addition of 2nd- 6th competition events.

Can my child or I participate in both youth 5.0 forms and adult 5.0 forms?

No, you must choose either youth 5.0 forms (forms 1-9) or adult 5.0 forms (short 1 - long 8). You will be disqualified if you do an adult form in a youth form division or a youth form in an adult form division. When choosing, keep in mind that Adult white through green belt forms do have an opportunity to compete for Grand Champions on stage.

How do the Grand Championships work?

Grand Championships are for brown & black belt competitors only. In order to make it to the Grand Championships you would have to win first place in one of the following events: Youth 5.0 Forms, Adult 5.0 Forms (only for Adult Brown/Black belt divisions), Open Forms, Open Weapons, or Self-Defense. Some groups might also have elimination rounds to pick the top two contenders for a Grand Championship after winning first place in their division.

For the safety of our students, replacing Grand Championships for 5.0 Fighting and 5.0 Grappling will be the 5.0 SUPERFIGHTS.

Do spectators have to pay?

No. Everyone can watch the test on Tuesday and the tournament on Wednesday and Thursday free of charge. However, the 'Dinner and A Fight' and the seminars are closed off to anyone except those with wristbands.

What if I miss the event due to an emergency, do I get my money back?

Full refunds will be given until May 31, 2026. June 1 – June 30, 2026 there will only be 50% refunds. No refunds will be given after June 30^{th} .

If I/my child decides not to participate in any tournament divisions, will we receive a refund?

No. After May 31, 2026 we cannot make any changes to the tournament divisions. Also, if students drop out of divisions at check-in or the day of the tournament, we will not be able to add them back in. We also cannot make division swaps at the event. So be sure you are certain of what you'd like to compete in, and update your registration before the May 31st deadline. If you need to remove a tournament division before May 31st, you will be refunded. Please email us.

If I/my child decides not to participate in the Friday night "Dinner and A Fight" banquet event, will we receive a refund?

No, we cannot offer refunds. The hotel requires final numbers and payment is made on those numbers prior to the event. Whether guests attend the event or not, our payment must be made to the hotel.

What do I do if my wristband comes off?

If your wristband comes off, you must turn in your old wristband to receive a new one. No replacements without turning in old wristband.

After I have registered for the event, can I log back in and add "Dinner and A Fight" banquet event wristbands?

Yes, you may login in and add up to seven additional wristbands as you need up to the deadline of May 31, 2026. If you need more than seven, please email.

What do I do if I have a family member who wants to purchase their own "Dinner and A Fight" banquet event wristbands?

We suggest adding it to your SMOOTHCOMP account after you finish your registration. You would be able to input their payment information at checkout (This way it will help keep things organized). If this is not possible, they can create their own SMOOTHCOMP account and purchase tickets directly (Please make sure they make a note of participants name).

What is 5.0 GRAPPLING event?

All of the same 5.0 Fighting rules apply except there will be no striking during this event, no fighting gear required, only groin guard and mouthpiece. Look in rules and regulations booklet for more information.

What does the 'MMA Training' mean on the registration?

We would like to know if the participant has any mixed martial arts training outside of Kenpo 5.0. If they attend or attended any other studios or had any kind of MMA, Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu, Muay Thai, boxing, kickboxing training. We also need to know if the participant has had any amateur/professional fights; so they can be placed in the correct division according to their experience as follow:

Up to 6 months of MMA, Kick-boxing, or Muay Thai training then you will compete in the Brown Belt division for 5.0 Fighting.

More than 6 months or have at least one amateur or one professional fight you will compete in the Black Belt division for 5.0 Fighting.

If the competitor is ranked in more than one **system**, or **program** within Kenpo 5.0, then the competitor will compete with their highest ranking.
